This is a fine quality antique Victorian oil painting of a Scottish highland loch and castle, by F. E. Jamieson, circa 1900, in its original gold leaf frame, in excellent original condition. The artist was famous for how he romanticised the Highlands, popularised by Queen Victoria. F. E. Jamieson sold his pictures to wealthy tourists during the Victorian and Edwardian period. The Victorian Scottish highland loch painting depicts a derelict castle standing on top of a hill in the background. The artist has a good way of depicting the sun catching top of mountains, and showing still depth of the water, as the sun sets, with a fishing boat moored near the water's edge. The timing of the day is emphasised by the pink on the mountains and the...

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
