Elegant George VI sterling silver three-piece tea service. Round baluster bodies are raised on stepped pedestal feet and are trimmed with delicate garland borders depicting swags and ribbon bows. The sugar bowl and creamer have typical Art Deco geometric handles with pyramid decorations. The teapot has ebonised finial and handle. Made by A E Poston & Co and fully hallmarked for Birmingham, 1937. total weight - 654 g teapot - 418 g sugar bowl and creamer - 236 g teapot - 14 cm tall, 26 cm spout to handle, 14 cm across at widest point milk jug - 7.5 cm tall, 12.5 cm spout to handle, 8 cm diameter on top sugar bowl - 6.5 cm tall to rim, 13.5 cm handle to handle, 9 cm diameter on top Sugar bowl and creamer in excellent vintage condition. Teapot has few small dings to one side and a shallow indent to another side; small ding to base of teapot; some tea staining inside the teapot appropriate to use.
