Dating to the 1900's, it features ruby eyes on the skull and crossbones, showcasing meticulous enamel work and intricate detailing. Crossed swords and a knight's helm complement the design. The acronym "FCB" represents Friendship, Charity, and Benevolence, embodying the values of the Knights of Pythias which was founded in Washington, DC in 1864 and was the first fraternal organisation to receive a charter under an act of the United States Congress.
