Description

A fine quality George III period figured mahogany 8 day painted dial longcase clock by Hodgson of Preston c.1780. The figured mahogany case with swan neck pediment to the top and inlaid band sat over the hood door, reeded pilasters set either side of the hood. Quarter columns to the trunk with shaped top door and inlaid band to match the hood. Cantled corners to the base with moulded plinth below and small ogee bracket feet forming the foot. The 8 day bell striking movement with anchor escapement sat behind a painted dial. The dial the strawberry blossom decoration to the corners and birds of paradise to the centre, typical of Lancashire clocks of this period. Roman numerals and blued steel hands, secondary seconds and calendar dial.
