With a central lift-up writing slope flanked by banks of short drawers. The slope lifts up to reveal an interior with stationary compartments. The writing surfaces are fitted with sumptuous red leathers completed with gilt tooled decorations to the surrounds. The base of the desk with a series of 8 short drawers. The writing slope and all drawers are lockable (keys supplied) and the drawers are all fitted with their original solid brass handles.
