A pair of antique Derby boy and girl porcelain figurines, end of 18th century, showing a girl with basket of flowers and a boy with his hat full of fruits. Both have been hand painted in enamel and decorated in finery with gilt highlights. These figurines have been made with exceptional care; their natural postures, facial expressions and beautiful clothes all speak of the highest level of master attention. The figures are dressed in traditional clothes, painted in vibrant colors and decorated with flowers patterns. The pieces are very finely hand-painted with excellent detailing, including the floral patterns and clear facial details. Predominant colors are vibrant shades of dark blue, yellow, green and pink. The figures sitting on an oval florally decorated and scroll moulded base with some greenery and applied flowers. All details of the figurines are made very realistically with the highest manufacturing technique. On base painted factory crown mark in red which confirms the stated date of manufacture of these rare Derby figurines.
