Description

A very poetic floral still life with roses and marguerite daisies by French artist Yves Trévedy (1916-1990). Born in Brittany, Trévedy had a distinguished career, studying in Paris first at the National School of Decorative Arts and then, in 1936, the National School of Fine Arts where he took classes with Louis Roger. He was awarded the first prize of Rome in 1943, with a travel grant to spend a year at the Villa Medici. Six years later, he was awarded a scholarship to the Casa Velasquez in Madrid. He exhibited at the Salon of French Artists, The Salon d'Automne and the Salon des Tuileries, with private shows in Paris, Lausanne, Geneva, Brussels du Salon des artistes français. Il expose au Salon d'Automne, au Salon des Tuileries. Expositions personnelles à Lausanne, Genève, Bruxelles and Paris. A superb colourist, Yves Trévedy created a universe of his own, bridging the gap between figuration and abstraction. Our painting by the artist dates from the 1950s and was acquired from the Galerie Cardo, a prestigious gallery in the 16th arrondissement. Measuring 41 x 33 cm, the overall size in its luxurious, original frame is 64 x 55 cm. Frame with some wear and repair and ...
