The clock front features ornate inlaid panel work, marquetry and edge stringing, and displays via an ornate white enamel with black Arabic numerals and gilded mask and gilded surround. Japy Freres was a french clock and watchmaking firm founded in 1806 by Frederic Japy with his son's Pierre, Fritz and Louis creating the trademark 'Japy Freres' (Japy Brothers).
