The fall front drops down to reveal an arrangement of pigeon holes to the interior and a leather writing surface (worn). A nice sized bureau that would work well in a hall or living room as an occasional desk. The fall and bottom drawer locks and comes with working keys.

Some old splits to the mahogany which have been filled with wax, some old mends to the decorative spandrels and some wear and veneer lifting to the feet in places.
