These handsome antique menu holders have octagonal bases which are fully hallmarked for Birmingham 1904, marked with Rowell Oxford to the underside and come in a fitted Goldsmiths & Silversmiths Company case. Birmingham. Maker's mark JWB. Date letter e for 1904. Marked to the underside with the retailer of Jeweller Rowell of Oxford. Also marked with the reg design number 454426.
