Description

- This was made as an oil lamp probably in Paris in the Belle Epoque period when Japanese and Chinese designs were the height of fashion.
- The high-quality Japanese satsuma vase was ordered and imported to fit the Japanese style French ormolu fittings.
- The figures represent finely dressed children of a high-status family playing in a garden. The almost three-dimensional enamelled scenes are richly embellished with gold leaf.
- Given its original function as an oil lamp the Satsuma vase is in exceptional condition having no chips or cracks and just the most minor 'touch' wear to the gilding in a few places.
- Carefully rewired as a lamp for use with modern lamp shades.
- NOTE excludes lamp shade.
