Above the Doors are 2 Mahogany Lined Drawers Which are of a Cushion Form. Cushion-shaped drawers are a distinctive feature in furniture design, particularly popular in the 17th and 18th centuries. These drawers are characterized by their convex, rounded fronts, resembling the shape of a cushion.
