Description

A truly beautiful Timuri rug, possibly made by the Dokhtar-e-Qazi tribe in the borderlands of north-eastern Persia and north-western Afghanistan circa 1900. The overall field design of small shrubs is typical of the Dokhtar-e-Qazi tribes. The main madder-red border is unusual with a flower and vine pattern and surrounded on both sides by interlinking 'S' symbols on a pale yellow background. The rug is in excellent condition, complete with stunning brocaded skirts, albeit the lower left corner has a very slight nibble out of it which I am having restored. A truly superb rug. Size: 1.70m x 0.84m (5' 7" x 2' 9").
