Two chicks can be seen in the foreground tussling over a piece of cabbage leaf as a hen and cockerel watch on. Meanwhile, others hens have emerged from the barn to peck at some leaves out of an overturned metal pail. Edgar Hunt was born in Fulham, London on 10 March 1876 to the genre artist Charles Hunt (1829-1900) and his wife Anne Sarah Kilbee. His brothers Reuben Hunt (1857-1938), Walter Hunt (1860-1941) and Claud Hunt (1863-1948) also inherited their father's talent and became successful artists. The family lived at 8 Granville Road in Wandsworth where his father kept a studio. Hunt and his brothers were all tutored by Charles and his influence can be seen in their style and subject matter. However, it was his older brother Walter who inspired him to specialise in animal paintings and whilst young, he began sketching farm animals, develo...
