Each side has a typically Regency Lion's head ring handle, complimenting the Lion's paw feet. The interior is totally original with lidded compartments with all sorts of bits and bobs which came with the box and are included. These include some period Mother of Pearl spools, a thimble, some old needle packs and all sorts of trimmings.
