The front legs have original brass castors. The leather is in great condition, with a great patina and loads of character, with no tears. These chairs have been given a light clean. Great quality with excellent leather and good proportions. During the 19th century, leather library chairs were highly prized and sought-after items in any well-appointed library or study. These chairs were typically crafted from high-quality materials, such as fine-grained leather, hardwood frames, and hand-carved details.
