A small silver gilt ewer, the handle in the shape of a female figure, the spout with carved mask standing on a gadrooned base with wooden plinth bearing the name of Mappin and Webb. The ewer is inscribed "Presented to the Epsom & District Chrysanthemum Society, Won By 1911 J Newton Mappin Esq" it appears Mr Mappin won his own trophy! The ewer is stamped MW, London 1909 and weighs 14 oz. The silver is thick and if necessary the inscription could be taken out. A fine shape. The height including the plinth is 19cm.
