Regarding the location, the ship in the background bears a strong resemblance to Aureol, named after the mountain in Sierra Leone, which she served. And finally, the Aureol appears to be in Freetown with Aureol mountain in the background. ARTIST Charles Cameron Cameron Baillie - Native Islanders in a Boat taking out provisions to the liner on the horizon in the far distance. A very decorative oil painting in original satinbirch frame signed by the artist lower left. Inscribed on the back "smoke room". This painting could well have been painted for one of the Staterooms on an interwar liner or cruise ship possibly like the one to be seen in the top left corner. Lovely painting. I think you'll find it's from the ship MV Eboe of the Elder Dempster Line. 655 is her yard number so that would fit, the subject matter matches with her intended route and service. Also the ship on the horizon I think is the Aureol, which was the company flag ship at the time s...
