A good pair of George V solid silver serving spoons in the Arts & Crafts style, with riveted edge design, made by Lee & Wigfull. Hallmarked Sheffield 1919/21. Each spoon with bright gilded bowl. There is a registered design number to the reverse of each spoon which shows that the pattern was registered in 1905; in the Arts & Crafts era. Lee & Wigfull was founded in the 1860s by George Lee & Henry Wigfull. Although Lee had left the business by 1870, Henry Wigfull continued with the same company name and they remained in business into the 1950s.
