The Union Flag was also used as the official flag of several British colonies and dominions before they adopted their own national flags. The flag continues to have official status in Canada, by parliamentary resolution, where it is known as the Royal Union Flag. It is sometimes asserted that the term Union Jack properly refers only to naval usage, but this assertion was dismissed by the Flag Institute in 2013 after historical investigations. This flag is of historical significance as there were three Monarchs during the period of 1936-1937; George V who died in 1936, Edward VIII who abdicated, never having had his Coronation and subsequently George VI who was the father of the late Queen Elizabeth II. There is some wear and creasing visible from past display and possibly minimal soiling present from age, but otherwise there is no notable damage to...
