Description

This exquisite mid-18th century French porcelain cup with a cover and saucer is a fine example of Sèvres-style craftsmanship. The cup is richly decorated with hand-painted flowers in shades of pink, red, purple, and yellow, all framed in gold gilt and features hand-painted floral garlands, gold wreaths, and purple ribbons and bows. The saucer, adorned with polychrome and gold decoration, matches the cup with its own hand-painted floral garlands, gold wreaths, and purple ribbons and bows. The cover is topped with a golden cherry and a couple of leaves. The cup and saucer bear the blue underglaze Sèvres mark 'Double-Louis' with the letter 'C', dating them to 1755-1756. This piece is an extraordinarily delicate work, showcasing the artist's skill in creating intricate floral compositions.
