Period of George II. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown, no chips cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 14.7cm, Rim diameter: 7.3cm, Folded Foot diameter: 8.2cm. **Historical Relevance** This glass was made approx 20 years prior to James Cook's landing at Botany Bay in Australia and approx 5 years after the Jacobite defeat at Culloden in Scotland.
