Myles Birket Foster 1825-1899. Prominent and highly regarded landscape and figurative painter. Born in North Shields; came to London when he was five. Began as a wood engraver under P. Landells when he was sixteen. Taught himself to paint in the 1850s and became a highly accomplished watercolourist. Travelled all over Europe and was admired by many leading artists of his day. He exhibited widely, and many museums and collections own examples of his work.
