The opposing link is ornamented with a cast and applied white gold fleur-de-lis. The links secure to the reverse with a 9ct yellow gold five link chain. The reverse of each cufflink is struck with the maker's mark (BN - Benjamin Ninnes). These antique cufflinks are fitted to the original leatherette presentation box, with a green satin and velvet lining and securing with a push fit catch. The interior of the box bears the retailer's mark B. Ninnes Goldsmith, Hythe. Condition: These impressive antique gold regimental cufflinks are excellent quality and a superior gauge of gold. The cufflinks are in excellent condition, with clear hallmarks to the reverse of each link. The decoration to each cufflink is very sharp; the detail determines these cuff...
