The trunk also with reeded quarter pillars with Satin Birch Capitals. The plain base with small bracket feet. The hood with reeded and brass capped angle pillars. The swan neck top with brass paterae, a brass eagle finial and typical Scottish Satin Birch fretwork. Height: 6'10"
