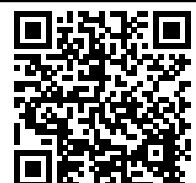

The hinged lid opening to reveal an immaculate gilt lined interior. Bears the makers mark for Chester silversmiths George Nathan & Ridley Hayes along with clear hallmarks.
