The twin flap compartment in front revealing a delightful divided interior with three liquor glasses and a cut glass dish. There is a secret spring action drawer in the base, which can be opened by pressing the hidden push button in the centre. Used for storing games paraphernalia revealing playing cards, dice and a cribbage board with score markers. Complete with working Bramah lock and the original key.
