It is made of exquisite ormolu (finely gilded bronze) mounted with delicately painted Sèvres style porcelain. The Porcelain is decorated with a pompadour rose pink background, the panel below the dial is delicately painted with cherubs. The porcelain dial shows a lovely depiction of cupid as a cherub with his arrow. Above the dial is a porcelain urn, delicately painted with a floral swag and mounted with ormolu handles and a pineapple finial. The rear door is glazed with convex glass to allow the movement to be seen. Please note that this style of clock does not have a glazed bezel over the dial. The French movement is of high quality and is by Japy Frères. It is in excellent clean and running condition having been fully overhauled by our clockmaker. Pendulum is original.
