Printed on on one side only of heavy laid paper, (a blank pair of pages between each entry) These engravings are most likely cut from An Explanation of Dassier's Medals of the Sovereigns of England, a series of six engraved plates of the Kings and Queens of England, by Pye, c. 1773, the final plate with additional medals of George III and Queen Charlotte. Excellent tight binding, professional repair to the calf on the spine Very good clear plates. Inscribed in ink, probably by the original owner Sarah Blencowe Adams November 9th 1799 in good condition with good plates
