Description

Arthur Reginald Smith was born in Skipton-in-Craven, Yorkshire, and grew up in Threshfield. He studied art at Keighley School of Art and spent his holidays sketching. He then attended the Royal College of Art (1901-4), and was awarded a travel scholarship which enabled him to travel to Italy in 1906. He exhibited at such leading London venues as the Royal Academy, the Royal Institute of Painters in Watercolours, and other public and private galleries. "The Hillside Village," Wharfedale, is a fine example. Measuring 11"x 20" it is framed in the original oak frame giving an overall size of 21"x 30". It is signed and has the original title "The Hillside Village" inscribed on the back. There is also a label for J. Barber on the reverse.
