A superb silver table lighter of rare design, assayed at the collectable Chester office and made by the great Sampson Mordan. This excellent Edwardian example is modelled as a world globe and stands on a raised and weighted base for stability. The globe is fully articulated, with a support framework and swivel points in silver facilitating free movement. To the top is a wick holder which is removable for replacing the oil/spirit and taper. The lighter is usefully designed to allow disassembling for cleaning, as seen the in photographs. A wonderful piece, being collectable, usable and decorative. Dimensions below.
