Description

Framed oil on panel of a village landscape. The painting is signed by the artist - Paul Caron (1874 - 1941) and is mounted in a more recent gilt frame with slip. Caron was born in Montreal, Quebec, where he studied drawing and painting under William Brymner, Maurice Cullen and Edmond Dyonnet at the school of the Art Association of Montreal. He worked 11 years in the stained glass industry making drawings for ornaments and figures and then for La Presse and the Montreal Star doing pen and ink drawings. He was a designer and illustrator for magazines but eventually turned to full time painting particularly of old buildings and ancient areas of Montreal and Quebec City. He favoured winterscapes and painted many rural scenes in the Laurentians of which several were reproduced on Christmas cards. He worked in watercolour using only distilled water and took great care in the selection of his materials to insure permanency. He exhibited with the Royal Canadian Academy and the spring shows of the Art Association of Montreal; Ontario Society of Artists, and the Fine Arts Section of the Canadian National Exhibition. He won the Jessie Dow award prize for watercolours in 1931 and 1...
