Overglaze polychrome painting, heavily gilt details, and hand painted flowers and blue feathered bird image which contrasts nicely with the rich gilding. This decorative vase has a floral design on the front of the vase in complimenting shades of gold, white and blue. The painting is accented with gold paint, the top of the vase is also decorated in gold and has a "cut out" pattern and scrolled ear shape handles. On the bottom Martial Redon company mark according to the stated time of production. It is a graceful and elegant Limoges vase to take pride of place in your collection. In 1853, three founders - Pierre-Justin Gibus, Alpinien Margaine and Martial Redon - set up the company 'Gibus et Cie' and decided to build another hard porcelain factory in Limoges. This is how the manufacture Le Pré des Bénédictins came into being in the city. The organizer of the business at that time became Pierre-Justin Gibus,...
