They are approximately 31 1/2" (80cm) high and 26" (66cm) wide across the arms. The seats are approximately 17 3/4" (45cm) high and 19" (48cm) deep. They are in good condition for their age. They have developed a lovely aged patina and are strong and sturdy chairs. They are not without a few small marks and knocks and signs of age and use but no major damages or anything detrimental.
