The foot presents additional decorations of scrolled foliage which are a testament to its "no-cost cut" design and displays the intricacy of the craftsmanship of this era. Its spout and handles are equally regal extending outwards with further acanthus leaf decorations which complete the overall look and contribute to a three-dimensional design.
