The cutlery set exudes opulence and splendour with its fully silver gilt/ vermeil (gold on top of solid silver) design which certainly is captivating whether on display or in use. In addition to its regal tone, the set presents a wonderful French flatware pattern with vine decorations along the sides with accents of grapes. The sugar tongs are particularly ornate and delightful with lion feet design, contributing to its overall majestickness. The set consists of 7 spoons, a sugar tong and a strainer. Owing to its gilding which protects the silver from tarnishing, this set may be perfect not only as interior decor but to use practically and enjoy an opulent afternoon tea in the most indulging manner. Overall an exquisite mid-19th c. French silver set with flair and elegance, ideal for elevating the splendour of any interior or setting.
