This exquisite Fairyland Dragon Lantern Bowl, created by Daisy Makeig-Jones for Wedgwood between 1915 and 1920, is a stunning example of early 20th-century ceramic art. The piece bears the Wedgwood gold stamp and pattern number Z4829, confirming its authenticity and rarity. The bowl's unique shape is rarely seen, making it particularly attractive to collectors of Daisy Makeig-Jones works. The combination of a lustre finish and skillful gilding exemplifies the innovative technique and artistic vision of Daisy Makeig-Jones. Susanna Margareta 'Daisy' Makeig-Jones was an influential pottery designer for Wedgwood, renowned for her Fairyland Lustre series, which appeared shortly after she became a full-time designer in 1914. She masterfully combined underglaze variegation, overglaze grain, and iridescence with intricate gilded designs, creating a completely new and captivating style in stoneware. The first ten lustre series, including this bowl (pattern Z4829), showcased Daisy's innovative use of color and design.
