Description

This exquisite antique bowl, featuring a low stem and a hummingbird depicted inside, was created by Daisy Makeig-Jones for Wedgwood between 1915 and 1920. The outer rim of the bowl showcases flying birds against a shimmering blue, glittery background, while the inner rim also depicts birds in flight. This small and graceful bowl is a stunning example of early 20th-century ceramic art. The base of the bowl bears the Wedgwood backstamp—Portland Vase Mark with three stars under the vase—confirming the authenticity of the piece. This unique bowl shape is rare, making it particularly attractive to collectors of Daisy Makeig-Jones' work. Susannah Margaretta 'Daisy' Makeig-Jones was an influential pottery designer for Wedgwood, best known for her Fairyland Lustre series, which debuted shortly after she became a full-time designer in 1914. She masterfully combined underglaze variegation, overglaze iridescence, and intricate gilded patterns to create a completely new and mesmerizing style. The Shine series, which includes this bowl (pattern Z5294), showcases Daisy's innovative use of color and design. Produced between 1914 and 1929, these early pieces have become highly sought after...

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
