Description

C19th Anglo-Indian carved padauk pedestal sideboard. Finely and profusely carved padauk Anglo-Indian pedestal sideboard of inverted breakfront form, The twin pedestals each with carved 'sun-burst' type panels to the doors and ends, interiors fitted with a cellarette drawer and shelves respectively. Heavily carved gadrooned bases with an ovolo or 'egg-and-dart' carved edge to the top. The 3 frieze drawers fronts carved with roundels, together with leaf and floral details with corresponding carving to side returns. Fitted with an elaborate carved and pierced shaped upstand back. The whole raised on turned bun feet. In excellent original condition, the high grade quality of well-selected padauk has achieved a rich, deep colour and patina. The top having a minor shrinkage crack along the grain to one end. Provenance: A local Worcestershire family by descent, acquired in British India during Government Service. *NB.
