An exceptional 18th-century German or Austrian walnut and fruitwood commode, of elegant bombe form, richly decorated with finely executed marquetry. The drawer fronts are inlaid with interlocking C-scroll motifs, framed within geometric reserves, displaying a sophisticated contrast between warm walnut and lighter fruitwood veneers. The top features a central panel with similar scrolling ornament, demonstrating a cohesive decorative scheme typical of Southern German and Austrian cabinetmaking of the mid to late 18th century. The commode retains its original brass handles and escutcheons, and stands on carved bun feet, reinforcing its Baroque influence. The veneers show a lively figuring, with strong colour and depth, enhanced by age and patina.
