It seems to be a popular route as several horseback riders are resting while an old cart clatters around the corner. It's an idealised look back into a time gone by. A romantic notion of yesteryear. The style and subject of the painting are reminiscent of some 17th-century Dutch landscape paintings. During this period, the Dutch middle classes looked to buy works they could relate to.
