An 8-day duration double fusee mechanism striking the hours on a bell of high quality. Circa 1860. Edward Hardy of Wells (Somerset) is recorded in A J Moores' 'Watch and Clockmakers of Somerset' book as working from 1842-1875. He worked in the High Street and Priest Row.
