Exhibited works at the Royal Cambrian Academy, Walker Art Gallery, Liverpool and Manchester City Art Gallery. Carrick Castle is a 14th-century tower house on the west shore of Loch Goil on the Cowal Peninsula, in Argyll and Bute, west of Scotland. It is located between Cuilmuich and Carrick.

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
