A handsome hall chest of splendid proportion, for a drawing room, study, bedroom etc., versatile furniture piece for day rooms or bedrooms, with good depth, height and width, generous scale with an established presence. The chest is arranged with 2 drawers, featuring walnut veneer with feather banding and original handles, the veneer shows a timeworn patination with areas of historic lifting of veneer, no evidence of losses evident the veneer is very stable. The top has matching feather banding to the drawer fronts, it is possible the chest is the original lower section of a possible chest on chest configuration that was later adapted to this more practical size.
