This beautiful Wedgwood bowl showcases a stunning goldfish design from the Fairyland Lustre collection. Crafted with the finest materials, this piece will elevate any home decor. Wedgwood's attention to detail and quality is evident in every aspect of this exquisite bowl. In 1909, Daisy Makeig-Jones was hired by the Wedgwood firm in Staffordshire, England, to decorate pottery. She later developed the "Fairyland" Lustre pattern, which combined dazzling iridescent glazes with moti...
