A most unusual pair of napkin rings, still ensconced in their original silk and velvet lined presentation box. Each shaped almost like a horse's hoof, they are engraved with a typically Victorian fern decoration leaving a vacant cartouche at the front, which of course could be personalized by your silversmith should you desire. Made from a thick gauge of silver, they weigh a combined 74.1 Grams / 2.38 Troy Ounces. Both have good crisp hallmarks for Sheffield 1897, making these a true Victorian pair. The makers initials are also present for the well renowned English silversmith, Roberts & Belk; each also has the oil lamp stamp associated with this silversmith.
