The ormolu banded lid has a Horne's patent hinge with beautiful banded parquetry decoration opening to a casket for jewellery, etc. It features matched veneers inlaid with scrolling leaves and the cabriole legs are united by an incurved undertier. The word derives from the Old French parchet, literally meaning "a small enclosed space". Large diagonal squares...
