The body is rectangular shaped with a glazed ormolu mounted door with glazes sides and features three fantastic floral marquetry panels. The interior is lined with the rich original violet velvet fabric which beautifully compliments the cabinet. Complete with the original working lock and key. Condition: In excellent condition. The mercury is driven off in a kiln, leaving behind a gold-coloured veneer known as 'gilt bronze'...
