Description

This exquisite Fairyland Lustre footed bowl with celestial dragons, created by Daisy Makeig-Jones for Wedgwood between 1915 and 1920, is a vivid example of early 20th-century ceramic art. The piece bears the Portland vase mark on the bottom and pattern No. Z 4825, confirming its authenticity and rarity. The exterior features a mottled orange glaze with a gilt edge and base, adorned with gilt dragons, while the interior is finished in a luxurious blue mottled glaze ranging from blue to purple, with gold patterns along the inner rim and a symbol imitating a Tibetan sign in the center. This particular color combination was extremely rare for decoration. Susanna Margareta 'Daisy' Makeig-Jones was an influential pottery designer for Wedgwood, renowned for her Fairyland Lustre series, which was introduced shortly after she became a full-time designer in 1914. She masterfully combined underglaze variegation, overglaze grain, and iridescence with intricate gilded designs, creating a completely new and captivating style in ceramics. The First Ten Lustre ranges, numbered consecutively from Z4823 to Z4832, comprised ten distinct patterns, each with its own unique combination of lus...

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
