Description

This beautiful bowl, created by Daisy Makeig-Jones for Wedgwood, features intricate gilded decorations. The exterior is adorned with patterns resembling Tibetan signs and symbols over a mottled blue underglaze. The interior boasts a mother-of-pearl lustre finish, with a gilded dragon at the center and elaborate gilded ornamentation along the inner rim. The base is marked with the Wedgwood Portland vase maker's mark and the pattern number Z4831, confirming its authenticity. Susannah Margareta "Daisy" Makeig-Jones was a renowned pottery designer for Wedgwood, best known for her iconic "Fairyland Lustre" series. In 1914, Daisy became a full-time designer with her own studio. Inspired by the various decorative techniques used in ceramic production, she sought to create an entirely new and captivating style by blending three techniques: underglaze mottling, overglaze graining, and iridescence, combined with whimsical designs outlined in gilt. Daisy collaborated with her studio neighbor, James Hodgkiss, and his decoration team to bring her vision to life. In October 1914, the first pattern in the "First Ten Lustre" series debuted.
